Restrictions

An appointment must be scheduled for services to be used.

Additional discounts apply to eligible non-plan items only and cannot be used with other promotions and/or discounts.

Additional costs may apply if patient needs sedation, special equipment, or extra restraint.

We are not obligated to perform an anesthetic procedure if the doctor does not deem the kitten a good anesthetic candidate.

Pre-anesthetic blood work must be completed no more than 60 days prior to anesthetic procedures including routine spay and neuter. If the pre-anesthetic blood work has already been consumed from the plan more than 60 days prior to the anesthetic procedure, additional cost will incur for additional blood work testing.

If patient is in heat, pregnant or cryptorchid at the time of surgery, additional fees will apply.

Post-operative oral medications to go home are not included.

Vaccine boosters cover one full series. Normal charges will apply if patient requires additional doses.
